CONDITIONS GÉNÉRALES DE VENTE (2025)

Les présentes conditions, également accessibles sur le site www.ngsa.ch, sont réputées acceptées, sans réserve, par toute personne participant à la vente publique organisée en conformité avec les règles de l'A.I.N.P. ou portant une enchère. Elles pourront être amendées par des avis écrits ou oraux par Numismatica Genevensis SA (ci-après «NGSA») qui seront mentionnés au procès-verbal de vente.

Les présentes conditions de vente ont été établies en français et en anglais. En cas de divergence entre les deux versions, seul le texte français fait foi.

1 Examen des objets mis en vente et obligation de s'enregistrer avant la vente

- 1.1 Les acheteurs potentiels sont invités à examiner les biens pouvant les intéresser avant la vente aux enchères et notamment pendant les expositions.
- 1.2 Tout acheteur potentiel doit impérativement remettre à NGSA, avant la vente aux enchères, un formulaire d'enregistrement dûment complété et signé et présenter une pièce d'identité officielle en cours de validité. Il recevra alors un numéro personnel destiné à l'identifier, qui lui permettra d'enchérir. Toute fausse indication engagera la responsabilité de l'adjudicataire.
- 1.3 NGSA refusera systématiquement de laisser participer à la vente aux enchères toute personne qui ne lui aura pas remis un formulaire d'enregistrement dûment rempli et signé ou qui n'aura pas transmis une pièce d'identité officielle en cours de validité.
- 1.4 NGSA se réserve également le droit, à sa seule discrétion, de refuser à une personne le droit de participer à la vente et/ou de lui interdire l'accès à la salle.

2 Représentation

- 2.1 Tout enchérisseur est réputé agir en son nom propre et il sera personnellement tenu responsable de son enchère; il est notamment personnellement responsable du paiement du prix, des frais, des taxes et des commissions, des objets qui lui ont été adjugés.
- 2.2 L'enchérisseur peut toutefois agir au nom d'un tiers, à la double condition que (i) les pouvoirs qui lui ont été confiés figurent sur une procuration écrite dûment signée par le représenté et (ii) que le représenté ait été identifié et agréé par NGSA avant la vente. En cas de représentation autorisée, le représenté sera lié par les présentes conditions de vente.

3 Garantie de NGSA

- 3.1 Toutes les indications et descriptions dans ce catalogue sont données de bonne foi. L'authenticité de toutes les pièces présentées à la vente est garantie à toute personne participant à l'enchère à concurrence du montant d'achat total. Aucune réclamation pour cause de divergence d'opinions quant à l'état de conservation d'un lot n'est acceptée. Les lots comportant plus d'un objet sont exclus de toute réclamation. Aucune réclamation concernant des monnaies ou médailles vendues en « slabs » n'est possible une fois que ces derniers sont ouverts.
- 3.2 La seule autorité reconnue par NGSA pour statuer sur l'authenticité d'une monnaie ou médaille est l'expertise de l'ISBCC, de l'Association Internationale des Numismates professionnels (IAPN).

4 Déroulement des enchères

- 4.1 Les enchères suivent l'ordre des numéros du catalogue. Les prix figurant sur le catalogue servent de prix de départ.
- 4.2 Le commissaire-priseur se réserve le droit, à son absolue discrétion, de modifier l'ordre numérique du catalogue et/ou de séparer ou de joindre n'importe quel lot.
- 4.3 Le commissaire-priseur se réserve également à tout moment le droit, à son absolue discrétion, de retirer tout objet ou lot faisant partie de la vente ou de suspendre cette dernière.
- 4.4 L'offre d'un enchérisseur est définitive, si bien qu'elle ne peut souffrir aucun retrait de ce dernier.

5 Adjudication

- 5.1 La monnaie de référence est le franc suisse.
- 5.2 Sous réserve de l'art. 4.3, l'adjudication est faite au plus offrant.
- 5.3 Pendant la vente aux enchères, NGSA exécute les ordres d'enchérir qui lui auront été transmis par écrit avant la vente; si plusieurs ordres identiques sont reçus, le plus ancien prévaudra. Les demandes d'enchères par écrit ou par téléphone doivent être reçues au plus tard 24 heures avant le début de la vente aux enchères. NGSA n'assume aucune responsabilité pour les enchères effectuées par téléphone, par écrit ou via une plateforme de live bidding.
- 5.4 S'il y a litige entre deux enchérisseurs, le commissaire-priseur est en droit d'annuler la vente et de remettre immédiatement l'objet aux enchères au prix proposé par les enchérisseurs, tout le public présent étant admis à enchérir à nouveau.
- 5.5 Les profits et les risques passent à l'acheteur dès que l'adjudication a été prononcée; celui-ci ne devient toutefois propriétaire de l'objet, par la remise de ce dernier, qu'une fois que le paiement complet (notamment du prix, des frais, des taxes et des commissions des objets qui ont été adjugés) a été effectué.

6 Paiement

- 6.1 Toute personne qui se porte enchérisseur s'engage à régler personnellement le prix d'adjudication augmenté des frais à la charge de l'acheteur et de tout impôt ou taxe qui pourraient être exigibles.
En sus du prix d'adjudication, l'acheteur devra payer à NGSA une commission de 22,5% sur le prix d'adjudication. Cette commission demeure de 22,5% également en cas d'achat via le live bidding.
- 6.2 En cas de remise ou de livraison en Suisse, le taux de TVA applicable sera ajouté au prix d'adjudication et à la commission de vente, pour toutes les médailles et les monnaies en platine, argent, bronze et autres alliages non exonérés de TVA.
- 6.3 Le paiement du prix total (prix d'adjudication, frais, tout impôt ou taxe et la commission de NGSA) est dû immédiatement et doit être effectué, en francs suisses, au plus tard 15 jours dès réception de la facture. Un intérêt moratoire de 1% par mois sera dû en cas de retard de paiement.
- 6.4 Les lots acquis ne sont remis ou expédiés à l'acheteur qu'après le paiement intégral de la facture de vente aux enchères.
- 6.5 **Toutes les taxes éventuellement dues à l'étranger, telles que droits de douane et impôts sont entièrement à la charge de l'acheteur.** Certains lots peuvent être soumis à des restrictions d'importation. Il incombe aux acheteurs internationaux la responsabilité de vérifier les directives en matière de douane et de devise, en s'assurant que l'acquisition et la livraison des lots remportés soient autorisées sur leur territoire.

7 Exclusion de responsabilité

- 7.1 Est exclue toute responsabilité de NGSA, y compris pour un éventuel dommage causé par ses auxiliaires et mandataires dans l'accomplissement de leur travail.
- 7.2 En référence aux art. 6.4 et 6.5, NGSA décline toute responsabilité pour une suite éventuelle résultant de la non-observation par l'acheteur des prescriptions de douane, de change, etc.

8 Droit applicable et for juridique

- 8.1 Les présentes conditions de vente et toutes modifications ultérieures sont régies par le droit suisse et interprétées conformément à ce droit, à l'exclusion de ses règles de conflit de lois.
- 8.2 Tout litige qui naîtrait en rapport avec la validité, l'effet, l'interprétation, l'exécution ou la non-exécution des présentes conditions de vente sera soumis à la juridiction exclusive des Tribunaux de la République et canton de Genève, quel que soit le domicile ou le siège des parties, sous réserve d'un éventuel recours au Tribunal fédéral, à Lausanne.

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR AUCTION SALE (2025)

These general conditions, which are also available on the website www.ngsa.ch, are deemed to be accepted without reserve by all and any person attending the auction sale conducted according to the I.A.P.N. rules or taking part to the auction sale. The general conditions may be amended orally or in writing by Numismatica Genevensis SA (hereinafter referred to as "NGSA"); such amendment would be referred to in the minutes of the auction sale.

The general conditions exist in French and in English. In case of discrepancy between the two versions, the French version shall prevail.

1 Checking the goods and mandatory registration

- 1.1 Potential buyers are required to check the goods put up at auction prior to the sale, especially during their exhibition.
- 1.2 Any potential buyer must register with NGSA prior to the beginning of the auction sale by filing and signing a questionnaire and by showing his/her identity card or valid passport, prior to the sale. The potential buyer will then receive from NGSA a personal identification number allowing to bid during the auction. The potential buyer will be liable for all damages resulting from any misstatement in the questionnaire.
- 1.3 NGSA will systematically refuse to grant the access to the auction sale for potential buyers who will not have duly filed and signed the registration questionnaire or who will have not provided NGSA with a valid identity card or passport.
- 1.4 NGSA reserves its discretionary right to refuse to anybody, the access to the sale and the auction hall.

2 Agency

- 2.1 Bidders are deemed to act in their own name and they will be personally liable for their bid; bidders are especially personally liable for the payment of the purchase price, of all costs, taxes and commissions in relation with the allocated to them goods.
- 2.2 Bidders are however authorised to act in the name of a third represented party, subject to the twofold condition that (i) their powers are documented through a proxy duly signed by the third party and that (ii) the latter has been identified and accepted by NGSA prior to the sale. In case of authorised agency, the third represented party will be bound by these general conditions.

3 Guarantee of NGSA

- 3.1 Descriptions given in this catalogue are given in good faith. The authenticity of coins and medals is guaranteed to each participant in the bid for the total purchase price. Claims due to disagreement about the level of conservation of a lot are not accepted. Lots which contain more than one piece are excluded from claims of any kind. No claims will be accepted for coins or medals sold in "slabs" once they have been opened.
- 3.2 The sole authority recognized by NGSA for determining the authenticity of coins or medals is the expertise of the ISBCC, operating under the International Association of Professional Numismatists (IAPN).

4 Bidding

- 4.1 The sales follow the sequence shown in the catalogue. The prices in the catalogue are initial prices.
- 4.2 Notwithstanding the above, the auctioneer reserves the discretionary right to change the sequence shown in the catalogue and/or to split or join any goods and/or lots.
- 4.3 The auctioneer also reserves the discretionary right to withdraw any good or lot from the auction sale, and/or to interrupt the auction sale.
- 4.4 The bid made by a bidder is irrevocable and definitive. It cannot be withdrawn.

5 Auctioning

- 5.1 The prices are indicated in Swiss francs.
- 5.2 Subject to clause 4.3, the higher bid gets the auction.
- 5.3 During the auction, NGSA executes bid orders that will have been received in writing by NGSA before the auction sale. Where several bid orders have been received for the same good or lot and for the same amount, the first bid order shall prevail. Written or telephone bidding requests must be received no later than 24 hours before the start of the auction. NGSA accepts no responsibility for bids made by telephone, in writing or via a live bidding platform.
- 5.4 In case of dispute between two bidders, the auctioneer may cancel the sale for the concerned good or lot and put it immediately up for auction at the price offered by the above mentioned bidders, any attendee being entitled to bid again.
- 5.5 Risks and profits will be transferred to bidder upon auctioning. However, title passes to bidder only when the purchased good or lot is remitted to bidder and when the full payment (especially the payment of the purchase price, of all costs, taxes and commissions in relation with the allocated to them goods) is settled by the bidders.

6 Payment

- 6.1 Any bidder commits to settle personally the auction price, as well as all and any costs to be borne by the bidder, as well as all taxes due in connection with the auction sale.
In addition to the auction price, the bidder will have to remit to NGSA a 22,5% commission on the auction price. In case of purchase via Live Bidding, the amount of the commission will remain the same.
- 6.2 As far as medals and pieces in platinum, silver, brass and any non - VAT exempt alloy are concerned, and in case the purchased good or lot needs to be delivered within Swiss territory, the Swiss VAT will also be due on the auction price and on the commission.
- 6.3 The auction invoice (auction price, costs, taxes and commission) is due for payment immediately upon receipt and must be made, in Swiss francs, no later than 15 days upon receipt of the invoice. The auctioneer levies a default interest of 1% per month in case of delayed payment..
- 6.4 Purchased lots will only be handed over or dispatched to the buyer once the auction invoice has been paid in full.
- 6.5 **Any taxes due abroad, including but not limited to customs duties and taxes are to be fully borne by the bidder.** Some lots may be subject to import restrictions. International buyers are solely responsible for verifying customs and currency regulations and ensuring that the purchase and shipment of the lots they acquire are legally permitted in their jurisdiction.

7 Exemption of liability

- 7.1 NGSA accepts no liability for any damage, including damages resulting from the action or inaction of employees and agents.
- 7.2 In reference to clauses 6.4 and 6.5, NGSA has no liability whatsoever for any damage resulting from the breach by the bidder of any customs regulations, foreign currency exchange regulations and any other regulations abroad.

8 Governing law and jurisdiction

- 8.1 These conditions of sale and their subsequent amendments shall be subjects to Swiss law and interpreted according to Swiss law, not including private international law.
- 8.2 Any dispute regarding their validity, effect, interpretation, execution or non-execution shall be, notwithstanding the parties' domicile or seat, within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the Canton of Geneva, subject to appeal to the Swiss Federal Tribunal, in Lausanne.

The king Pagan Min became ensnared in a war in 1852 as the result of poor relations with British merchants. The British army invaded and removed him. In 1853, the British installed a new king, Mindon Min, as a friendly ally. He issued a new coinage based on the currency system used throughout British India, all of it dated 1852 in honor of the British victory.

Barghash was born around 1836–1838 to Omani sultan, Said bin Sultan and an Ethiopian concubine. He succeeded his elder half-brother Majid in 1871. Upon becoming sultan, his reign became successful and is credited with building much of the infrastructure of Stone Town, including piped water, public baths, a police force, roads, parks, and hospitals. He was the last Sultan to maintain a measure of true independence from European control. He consulted with European «advisors» who had immense influence, but he was still the central figure they wrestled to control. Furthermore, he crossed wits with diplomats from Britain, America, Germany, France and Portugal and was often able to play one country off against another. His coinage is extremely rare and historically important.
