Seit dem 1. Januar 2025 gilt eine neue, für alle Mitgliedsstaaten der Europäischen Union bindende Richtlinie (Richtlinie (EU) 2022/542). Handling of Auction Purchases via SINCONA Deutschland GmbH

As of January 1, 2025, a new directive (Directive (EU) 2022/542) has been in force that is binding on all member states of the European Union. This EU directive stipulates that, from January 1, 2025, goods imported into the EU from third countries (including Switzerland) can no longer be subject to margin scheme taxation, but can only be sold and invoiced at the standard tax rate.

Effective immediately, SINCONA Deutschland GmbH will **only process auction purchases with a shipping address within Germany or pick-up in person in Weil am Rhein**. Auction purchases will be shipped directly from Switzerland to all other EU countries, unless processing via SINCONA Deutschland GmbH and thus regular taxation for the recipient country is expressly requested.

Auktionsbedingungen

Für die SINCONA Auktion 99 gelten folgende Versteigerungsbedingungen, welche durch die Abgabe eines schriftlichen, elektronischen, mündlichen oder telefonischen Gebotes vollumfänglich anerkannt werden:

1. Die Versteigerung erfolgt freiwillig und öffentlich im Namen der SINCONA Swiss International Coin Auction AG für Rechnung des oder der ungenannt bleibenden Einlieferer und unter Beachtung der Regeln der International Association of Professional Numismatists (IAPN, www.iapn-coins.org).

2. Der SINCONA Swiss International Coin Auction AG (im Folgenden «Versteigerer» oder «SINCONA AG» genannt) unbekannt Bieter sind gebeten, sich vor der Auktion zu legitimieren. Ferner behält sich der Versteigerer vor, nach freiem Ermessen und ohne Angabe von Gründen Personen den Zutritt zu den Auktionsräumlichkeiten oder den Zugang zu den «Live Bidding»-Plattformen zu untersagen.

Der Versteigerer ist mit Zustimmung der Auktionsaufsicht berechtigt, von der im Katalog vorgesehenen Reihenfolge abzuweichen und Nummern zu vereinigen. Lose werden nicht aufgeteilt. 2. Bidders who are unknown to SINCONA Swiss International Coin Auction AG (hereinafter referred to as “Auctioneer” or “SINCONA AG”) are asked to prove their identity prior to the auction. In addition, the Auctioneer reserves the right to deny individuals access to the auction premises or the “live bidding” platform(s), at its own discretion and without stating a reason.

The Auctioneer is entitled, with the approval of the auction monitor, to deviate from the designated order in the catalog and to combine lot numbers. Lots may not be divided up. In case of disagreement, the Auctioneer may re-offer a lot. The auction is conducted in German and partly in English.

3. The Auctioneer executes absentee bids diligently and in the best interests of the respective bidder, however without liability. Absentee bids (including bids submitted electronically) can only be considered if they are received no later than 24 hours prior to the auction (or 1 hour for bids submitted via an Internet platform). 4. Only the descriptions of each respective lot number in the printed catalogue, and not the illustrations, are binding for the auction. The auction catalogue published on the internet is for information purposes only.

5. The prices in the catalogue are starting prices in Swiss Francs (CHF) and represent the minimum knock-down price. Bids that are lower than the starting price cannot be taken into account. Hammer prices are in Swiss Francs (CHF) and will be fixed following a call for the highest bid, which commits the highest bidder to purchase the lot. Mr. Prokop was a trader and a famous collector of Russian coins. During the Russian revolution the communists confiscated his collection, but he succeeded in buying most of his collection back. Next the communists entered Prague where he was keeping his saved collection and confiscated it again. After the collapse of Soviet Union the Prokop family received the collection back and they have been able to sell these treasures to private collectors.

An engaging relic from Peter the Great's program to "Westernize" Russia, beard tokens such as this reflected the tsar's fascination with contemporary Europe, where he saw that few men sported facial hair. Amidst the consternation at his request that all Russian men should shave their traditional beards, Peter allowed for men to keep their facial hair, provided they pay an annual beard tax, which tokens such as this were meant to serve as proof of.

The first square beard tax tokens had just been minted and all but two tokens that are currently in the national museum Hermitage were destroyed. This particular very rare token is a 19th century restrrike.

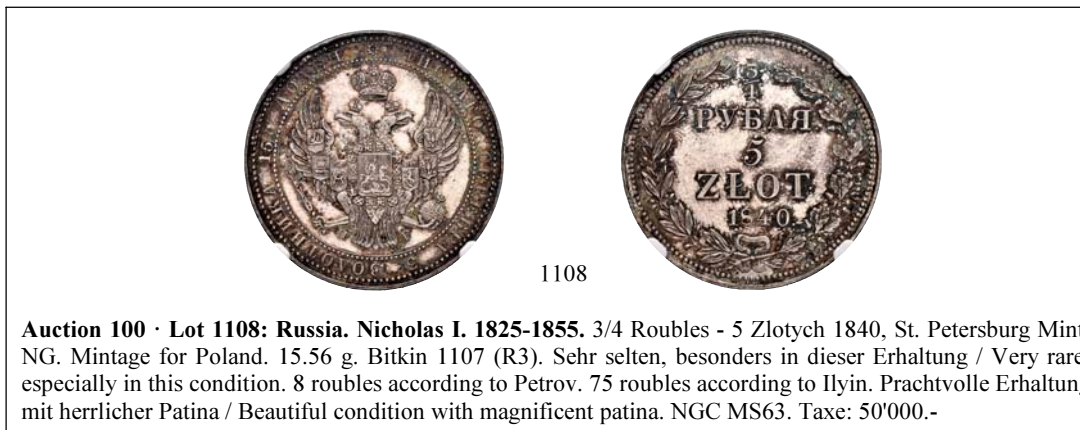

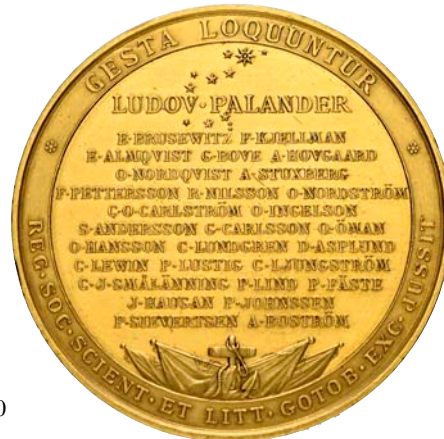

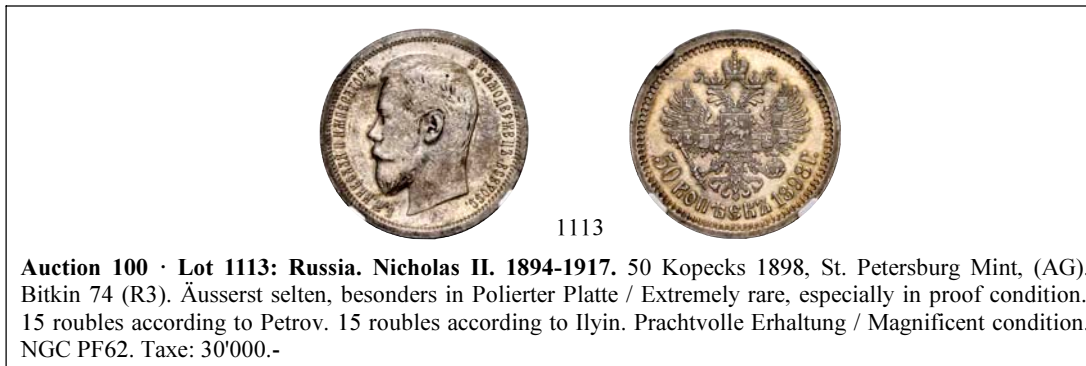

In the 1912 Stockholm Olympics, the Russian team came in second to last place among the 18 participating nations. One newspaper deemed it "the shame of all the Russian people." In order to prevent such an embarrassment in the future, Grandduke Dmitrii Romanov ordered the creation of a Russian Olympics as a means of practice and training. The first such Pan-Russian Olympics was held in the Kiev Sports Grounds in 1913. Located in the Lukianivka, the Sports Grounds was the first permanent sports stadium in the Russian empire (it was destroyed in WWI). Olympics, sports, Ukrainian, even Judaic -- this very rare award medal encompasses a number of topical interests. It was made by the renowned Jewish jeweler Joseph Marshak, one of the Karl Faberge's main competitors. Called the Cartier of Kiev, Marshak was responsible in 1913 for all the Imperial gifts presented to Nicholas II. The medal above was commissioned later that year. The city of Uzhhorod is the capital of the Transcarpathian Oblast in Ukraine and the seat of the administrative centre for the Uzhhorod Raion. It is located in the border triangle between Hungary, Slovakia and Ukraine, directly on the Slovakian border.

It was conquered by Hungary in the mid-11th century. The conquest of the rest of Transcarpathia was then completed by the 13th century. Until 1918/19, the city belonged to the Kingdom of Hungary under various princes and thus also to the Austrian monarchy from 1526 and to Austria-Hungary from 1867.

Under the Treaty of Trianon, Uzhhorod fell to the newly founded Czechoslovakia in 1919 along with Carpathian Ukraine. Until 1938, Uzhhorod was the capital of the autonomous Carpathian Ukraine within Czechoslovakia. As a result of the First Vienna Award of 2 November 1938, Uzhhorod, together with the southern strip of Carpathian Ukraine, became Hungarian again.
